## **Under 13 Age Group - Young Players in Adult Matches Consent Form**

Dear Parent/Guardian

Langley Manor Cricket Club encourage young cricketers to participate in matches at their own age groups and, where appropriate maturity and personal ability is shown, in adult matches as well.

Although the club are keen for young members to participate in these matches, the safety of these young players is of the utmost importance.

Your son/daughter has expressed an interest to play in adult matches.

The club will follow the EBC Guidelines for:

- ECB Junior Cricketers playing in Adult Matches
- ECB Fast Bowling Match Directives
- ECB Safety Guidance on the wearing of cricket helmets by young players
- ECB Fielding Regulations

The Team Captains have been provided with a copy of these regulations and will follow the guidelines contained within.

Copies of these guidelines and regulations are enclosed for your information and the club recommend that you are familiar with them before consenting for your son/daughter to participate in adult matches.

### Club Changing Policy:

For Players under the age of 17 playing in adult teams, the following policy applies.

- 1 Young players uncomfortable with changing or showering with adults are under no obligation to do so and are advised to change and shower at home.
- 2 Parental consent must be given if Young Players are to share changing facilities with adults.
- 3 If Young Players are sharing changing facilities with adults, parents (same gender) have the option to supervise them whilst they are changing. The Club will make reasonable efforts to arrange this.

**Consent by Parent / Legal Guardian** – Please strike out the words in bold print which you do not agree to.
