## Club Funds

In common with, it seems everything in the current economic climate; the club have to keep a close eye on the finances. The club do try to keep costs down as far as possible but there are costs that have to be met. Just to give members an idea of the costs involved and the reason why we have to charge what we do, a couple of recent unexpected costs that have had to be met this season. To start the season, the cool cellar broke down and the compressor had to be replaced and fitted to the tune of £350. Last week, the wicket roller, an essential piece of kit, decided to strip the teeth of the flywheel and had to have a new one fitted along with a new starter motor. This amounted to a total of nearly £900. This is on top of normal wear and tear maintenance. Club insurance this year was in the region of £1300, and ground rent is nearly £1000 so you can see that running the club is not a cheap affair.

Rest assured that the committee are committed to the wellbeing of the club and all income is used for running the club and improving club facilities, for example the new chairs and carpet in the clubhouse this season.
